Application Requirements

In order to apply for the scholarship, applicants must be a graduating high school senior and a member of PFCCU as of February 5, 2010. PFCCU's official family and staff's immediate families are not eligible.

PFCCU members who are graduating seniors and wish to be considered for the scholarship must complete the scholarship application form. The following documents must be completed and accompany the application:

- * A copy of the student's transcript
- * A teacher recommendation
- * A sponsor, coach or employer recommendation
- * A statement from the student

In order for the application to be considered, all of the above documents must be included and the application must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2010.

Award Information

The scholarship recipients will be notified on or before May 14, 2010.
